

# Mentoring-Commitment für »Students' Bauhaus.Modules«

Version: 09.04.2026

Student teachers need a mentor to carry out their student learning project as part of the "Bauhaus.modules". The following guidelines will inform you about the necessary tasks and should help you to fulfill them in the best possible and plannable way.

## Idea

The "Students' Bauhaus.Modules" are additional courses that are designed to be interdisciplinary and can be taken as part of a degree program. It must therefore meet the requirements of the German Rectors' Conference (HRK) in terms of the Qualifications Framework, have the aim of acquiring skills and formulate these in clearly identifiable requirements. This also applies to student-led learning projects.

## Announcement and Funding

Student learning projects can be supported by the "Bauhaus.Module" promotion fund. Applications are accepted

- for the winter semester from April, application deadline in June.
- for the summer semester from October, application deadline in December.

## Application Process / Mentoring Agreement

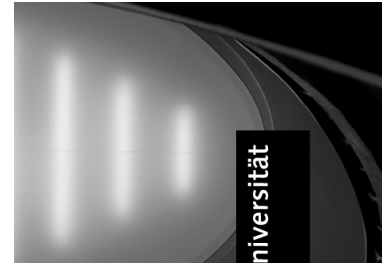
To ensure that the "Students' Bauhaus.Modules" can be credited, performance requirements and assessment criteria must be clearly defined. For this, the student teachers need your support as mentors, as only you can formally register the performance at the end of the semester and should be involved in the conception, objectives and implementation of the course.

The following points should therefore already be clarified with the student teachers when the mentorship is agreed. They are also necessary for the application and billing of the funding by the students:

- Coordination with student teachers on performance requirements (differentiated according to Bachelor's and Master's degree). In principle, courses in the "Bauhaus.Modules" should be open to both Bachelor's and Master's students.
  - A differentiated performance requirement should be defined according to the different qualification objectives.
