Job profile:

You will support the team in developing a research proposal on contemporary forms of authoritarian urbanism. Your tasks will mainly comprise the following areas:

- Support in data collection, preparation and analysis
- Conduct literature searches, preparation and analysis
- Support in case study identification and selection
- Support in organizational activities and other issues (e.g. preparation of presentations, manuscripts)

Requirements:

- Student of one of the Master programs in urban studies (e.g. M.Sc. European Urban Studies, M.Sc. Urbanistik, M.Sc. IUDD)
- Passion for research and research-related activities (reading, data collection, analysis etc.)
- Interest in (and basic knowledge about) contemporary urban developments, especially in (semi-)authoritarian contexts
- Very good knowledge of English (German is not required), further language skills are an asset
- Very good knowledge of Office programs (Excel, Word, Powerpoint), knowledge of Adobe programs is an advantage
