

**Information on the examination period in winter term 2025/2026 for the degree programs  
Informatik I Computer Science for Digital Media I Human-Computer Interaction I Digital Engineering**

The computer science department has set the **examination period** for the current winter term as follows:

09 February 2026 -13 February 2026	preparatory week
<b>16 February 2026 - 6 March 2026</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> exam period</b>
<b>16 March 2026 - 31 March 2026</b>	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> exam period</b> (Formale Sprachen, Diskrete Strukturen, Virtual Reality)

If possible, all exams and repeat exams offered by the Computer Science department will take place within this period. Beyond this period, examinations can only be held upon agreement with all participants (e.g. for repeat examinations)

The examination schedule will be announced in due time before the start of the examination period on our websites, as well as by e-mail (via our student mailing lists).

**Registration for the examinations offered by the Faculty of Media** will be possible via Bison-Portal between

**01 December 2025 and 22 January 2026.**

Please consult the homepage of the Bison portal for registration deadlines for exams from other faculties.

The deadlines for de-registration/withdrawal from examinations are set in the respective examination regulations.

In most cases, a withdrawal is possible up to four working days before the date of the respective exam.

You can deregister or withdraw from exams in Bison independently until the end of the registration period on 22 January 2026. Beyond that, withdrawal is only possible by email to the examination office and within the deadlines specified in your examination regulations.

**If you miss the registration deadline, registration is only possible in justified exceptional cases and after approval by the respective examiners.**

**Registration is required for all examinations (including oral examinations, term papers, projects, etc.).**
