



LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE: GENERAL INFORMATION

- The language certificate according to the CEFR: a compulsory document for your application
- Language: the language of instruction and/or the national or working language at the host university / in the host country.
- No language skills yet? Please write a short explanation and upload it with the application form.

General rule:

the language certificate cannot be older than 3 years at the time of application!

Exception: You can show that you have used the language in everyday life, e.g. study in English, work and travel.

Summary of the options for the language certificate



CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)



Sprachenzentrum: Centre for Language and Cultural Learning

1. LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE WITH HIGH-SCHOOL DIPLOMA (ABITURZEUGNIS)

The language must have been learnt for at least 7 years.

Translation of the points into the language level according to CEFR:

- = B19-10
- 11-12 = B2
- 13-15 = C1

A scan (PDF) of the high-school diploma must be submitted.



Options for providing the language certificate

2. LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE BASED ON A LANGUAGE COURSE

The language level according to CEFR (A1-C2) must be recognisable on the certificate.

Please submit evidence of a language course completed at the Language Centre of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar or another university.

3. PROOF OF LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY THROUGH AN INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE

English: TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge,

Pearson PTE etc.

French: DELF/DALF

Spanish: DELE

Options for providing the language certificate

4. OBTAINING A LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE ONLINE: FOR ENGLISH ONLY

For English, an online test is one option for assessing your language skills.

You can take the VEPT (Versant English Placement Test), which is administered by Pearson. It is a flexible test which you can take anytime and anywhere.

You will receive your score report directly afterwards.

You then only need to send your score report, along with your personal details, to the Language Centre.


