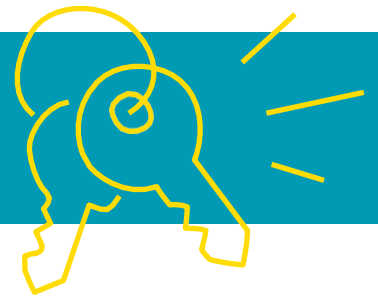


EXCHANGE WELCOME DAYS | ACCOMMODATION

As your Exchange Team, we would like to welcome you to Weimar!

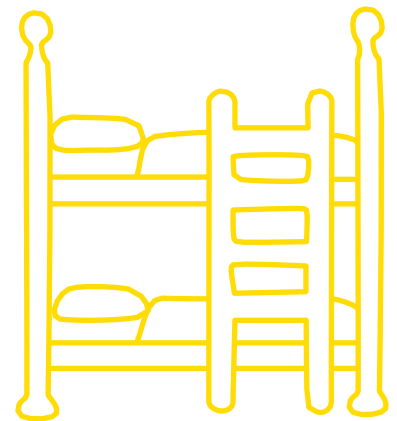

Below, we have put together some offers in case you are not yet able to move into your dorm room or flat during the Welcome Days.

Please be aware that there is an increased amount of interest in hostel rooms at this time of year, so it would be good to **book the room in advance**. Since Weimar is a small town, everything is within easy reach, either on foot or by bus - distances are not a big problem here. Once you have your Thoska card (student ID), you can also use the city buses for free.



ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS:



1| Labyrinth Hostel

Located in the heart of Weimar near Goetheplatz, Labyrinth Hostel Weimar offers individually decorated rooms, colourful décor and free Wi-Fi. Guests can use the shared kitchen to prepare meals and enjoy their free coffee or tea throughout the day. Other facilities at Labyrinth Hostel include a shared lounge with a free internet terminal and a rooftop terrace with a seating area to catch some sunshine.

2| A&O Hostel

The A&O hostel in Weimar is located in the immediate vicinity of the main railway station and is therefore well connected. The sights of the cultural city are only a small walk away from your accommodation. The rooms all have their own bathroom with shower and WC. In the lobby, you can relax at the bar or in cosy sitting areas after a busy day and make new plans. At the 24-hour reception desk of the hostel, the friendly staff will be happy to help you with any questions you may have.

3| Hummel Hostel

The Hostel is located in a historic Villa with a big garden in the center of Weimar. Everything is reachable by foot. For single rooms there are private toilets. You have access to free WiFi.
