Teamwork (max. 2 people) is permissible.

Twenty of the best designs will be admitted for the **exhibition**.

1. „Best Poster“ – prize for best poster design

- Presentation of your own scientific project, **structured cogently** and **generally understandable** for an external viewer,
- structured, self-explanatory and precise design as well as a transparent concept
- **optically attractive** (images, photos etc.), **clear and good legibility**.
- In German or English
- Poster size A0 (841mmx1189mm),
- Logo of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, according to the Corporate Design (actual font size 20 mm), colour and number of characters is unlimited (logo and colours are available on the Internet under

Exhibition

The posters will be exhibited during the „Wissenschaftstag“ (Wednesday 16th.11.2011) in the main university building. The poster exhibition takes place within the research colloquium from **3:30 PM**, concluding with the “Elevator Pitch” **presentations**. The most convincing posters and presentations will be awarded **prizes** in the categories design and presentation.

Jury & Prizes

The jury, which consists of young scientists of the four faculties at the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, will award the prizes for best poster design and best “Elevator Pitch” presentation:

- 1. Prize: Graphic and 200 Euro**
- 2. Prize: 150 Euro**
- 3. Prize: 100 Euro**
- 4. - 6. Prize: Certificates for events at the Careers Service**

Additionally, all winners will receive an official certificate from the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar

The award ceremony takes place directly following the closing words by the Rector.
