According to § 3 Section 1 in connection with § 33 Section 1 No. 1 of the Thuringian Higher Education Act (ThürHG) from 21 December 2006, (GVBl. P. 601), last amended by Article 12 of the law of 12 August 2014, (GVBl. p. 472), the Bauhaus Research School issues the following statutes; the statutes were passed by the Senate on 3 July 2015.

The statutes were approved by the Rector of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar on 18 July 2015.

### § 1 Legal form

The Bauhaus Research School is a central research institution of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, according to § 37 ThürHG and according to § 18 Basic Statutes of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.

## § 2 Objectives

The Bauhaus Research School is the umbrella organisation for all doctoral programmes of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar. The Bauhaus Research School objective is to support junior scientists, artists and designers as well as safeguarding and increasing the quality of doctoral education at the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.

## § 3 Mission Statement

The duties of the Bauhaus Research School in particular are:

- a. advisory consultation of the application procedure and support for the implementation of structured doctoral programmes for all research fields at the faculties,
- b. creating conducive framework conditions for all doctoral candidates and post-doctoral researchers at the university; this refers in particular to:
  - conceptualising and implementing an interdisciplinary qualification offer for doctoral candidates and post-doctoral scientists,
  - offering and coordinating services in particular for international doctoral candidates,
  - supporting interdisciplinary exchange between doctoral candidates and post-doctoral researchers,
  - provide specific support for doctoral candidates and post-doctoral researchers,
- c. supporting the quality assurance of doctoral projects,
- d. supporting the acquisition of scholarships and external funding.

## § 4 Members

(1) Members of the Bauhaus Research School may be:

- a. university lecturers, adj. professors of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar,
- b. doctoral candidates and post-doctoral researchers of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar,
- c. those in charge of coordinating doctoral programmes.

- (2) Doctoral candidates participating in doctoral programmes of the Bauhaus Research School are members of the Bauhaus Research School.
- (3) Independent doctoral candidates not connected to any doctoral programme of the Bauhaus Research School may make a written request for membership. As a presupposition for admission, the applicant must state the subject of their doctoral thesis, the name and the acceptance statement from the supervisor, present a confirmation of acceptance as a doctoral candidate by the respective faculty of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, as well as a letter of motivation.
- (4) Post-doctoral researchers (staff members holding a doctorate and scholarship holders) may be accepted upon written request. As a presupposition for acceptance, the subject of the research project and a tutor must be stated, also a letter of motivation.
- (5) Members of other universities participating in a programme of the Bauhaus Research School may be admitted.
- (6) Membership of the Bauhaus Research School expires:
  - with the end of the programme the member has participated in,
  - with the end of the research project or sub-project the member has been working for,
  - with the end of the scholarship,
  - due to withdrawal of membership or leaving the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar,
  - due to exclusion as a member (in particular violations against good scientific or artistic practice); the expulsion must be decided by the Directorate of the Bauhaus Research School,
  - by a letter of resignation.

## **§ 5 General Assembly**

- (1) The General Assembly consists of all members according to § 4 Sections 1 to 5. It is convened at least once a year by the Director of the Bauhaus Research School who acts as chairperson.

(2) The General Assembly has the following duties:

- a. making recommendations concerning all matters of the Bauhaus Research School,
- b. discussing and approving the report by the Director of the Bauhaus Research School.

## **§ 6 Directorate**

(1) The Directorate of the Bauhaus Research School consists of the Director, the Speakers of the doctorate programmes, two members according to § 4 Section 1b as well as the management as an advisory member. The members of the Directorate must be members of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.

(2) The members of the Directorate according to § 4 Section 1a are appointed by those applying for programmes. The members of the Directorate according to § 4 Section 1b are elected by the General Assembly in its membership group.

(3) The period of office of the Directorate is three years, for members according to § 4 Section 1 it is one year. Re-election is possible.

(4) The Directorate of the Bauhaus Research School has the following duties:

- a. deciding on all basic matters of the Bauhaus Research School according to § 3 Section 1,
- b. nominating the Director for appointment by the Rector,
- c. electing a Vice Director from the university professors in the Directorate,
- d. defining criteria for the admission of doctoral programmes in accordance with the Rector,
- e. deciding about the admission of doctoral programmes in accordance with the Rector,
- f. establishing a commission for granting external or scholarships provided by the Rectorate and funding for doctoral candidates and post-doctoral researchers; this commission is also in charge of deciding about regulations for the granting of scholarships and

funding, as far as such payments have not been determined by the respective funding authorities.

(5) The Directorate establishes its own rules of procedure.

## **§ 7 Director**

(1) The Bauhaus Research School is headed by a Director. The Director is elected, by nomination of the Directorate of the Bauhaus Research School, from the circle of university professors of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar. They are appointed by the Rector.

(2) The period of office is three years.

(3) The Director has the following duties:

- a. representation of the Bauhaus Research School both inside and outside the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar,
- b. calling and presiding over the General Assembly and the meetings of the Directorate of the Bauhaus Research School,
- c. reporting to the General Assembly and the Directorate,
- d. yearly reporting to the Senate of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.

## **§ 8 Office**

(1) The Bauhaus Research School is provided with its own office. The Director is in charge of the office which is administered by a management.

(2) The management has the following duties:

- a. running the current business of the Bauhaus Research School, including budget matters,
- b. preparing and implementing the decisions made by the Directorate of the Bauhaus Research School,
- c. providing support with the establishment of and applying for structured doctoral programmes and programmes of the highest possible artistic qualifications, as well as providing support with

- working out and further developing the study regulations of the respective programmes,
- d. providing support with scholarships and external funding,
  - e. coordination and organisation of interdisciplinary qualification offers in the context of the Bauhaus Research School.

## **§ 9 Commencement**

These Statutes become valid on the day after their announcement in the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar memorandum. At the same time the Statutes of 6 June 2007, (MdU 54/2007, p. 243), last amended by amendment record of 3 February 2010, (MdU 05/2010, p. 42) will become invalid.
