Masters and Diploma projects from students are also accepted.  
Teamwork (max. 2 people) is permissible.

Ten of the best designs will be admitted for the exhibition.

### Poster Guidelines:

- presentation of your own research project:  
coherent and generally understandable for an external viewer  
(short text, name and field)
- structured and self-explanatory design
- visually appealing (images, photos etc.), clear and legible lettering not less than 18 pt
- language: German or English
- poster size A0 (841mmx1189mm), portrait format
- logo of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, integrated according to the Corporate Design

The posters are to be presented to the audience during the exhibition with an "Elevator Pitch". You have a max of 90 seconds to present your poster (in German or English) in an exciting and gripping manner. The Elevator Pitch is a compulsory component of the poster contest.
