Open Access Policy of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar

The Bauhaus-Universität Weimar – represented by the members of the University Directorate and the Senate – is committed to the principles of Open Access publishing as laid down in the *Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities*. It advocates free and unrestricted access to scientific knowledge and recommends its scientists and scholars to publish their work in open access publications. In their opinion, the greater accessibility and strong networking of Open Access publications increases the public visibility of the research results of Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.

The Bauhaus-Universität Weimar provides its authors with an online publication service (OPUS) that is operated by the University Library, and is available free of charge. It recommends its scientists and scholars to publish their research results as first publications or as preprints or postprints on OPUS.

The Bauhaus-Universität Weimar encourages scientists and scholars to benefit from the opportunities that Open Access publishing already offers. This also applies to the secondary publication of the research results within the scope of (copyright) law. When entering into publication contracts, researchers should ensure that they include a non-exclusive right of use.

The University Library supports and advises authors on all issues concerning Open Access.
