- Further publications require a separate approval.
- Filming and photo-approval permits are issued based on o. G. appointments and only on presentation of a concept.
- Bauhaus-Universität Weimar reserves the right to charge for the use of its premises.
- The transfer of images or reprint rights to third parties requires a separate contract with the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar.
- The licensee is responsible for restoring all premises to their original condition prior to filming/photographing/recording. Change requests and conversions are subject to approval.
- The licensee is liable for personal injury and damage to property resulting from the filming/ photographing / recording, including preparation and handling, by the licensee him- or herself, his or her staff or any other agents.
- The licensee must indemnify the landlord for all third-party claims (persons and companies commissioned by the licensee, or possible clients of the licensee).
- The licensee guarantees that the activities that take place within the framework of the above mentioned work do not infringe on third party rights (especially copyrights and personal rights).
- Additional agreements must be in writing.
- The Bauhaus-Universität Weimar must be specified as the patron.
- The Bauhaus-Universität Weimar receives two complete copies of the publication/film free of charge and unsolicited.
- Please note that some of the artworks in our buildings may not be reproduced without permission and must be registered at VG Bildkunst.

We ask that you not disturb the course of studies at the University during your work and to refrain from taking photos or filming during your visit to workspaces and studios. If such recordings are part of your concept, feel free to contact us for exact dates and arrangements.

Notes on data protection

1. The data provided by you in this form will be processed by the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar alone for the stated purpose and will not be passed on to third parties. In accordance with Article 6, paragraph 1, lit. e, DSGVO, the processing of your data is necessary for a task that is carried out in the public interest.
