### OVERVIEW

In co-operation with the Language Centre of the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar, the Bauhaus Weiterbildungsakademie Weimar e.V. offers the following German intensive courses for prospective students from abroad:

Course	Target level/exam	Requirements
German: Elementary/pre-intermediate	B 1	Ca 300 hours (A 2)
German: Pre-intermediate/intermediate level	B 2	ca 600 hours (B 1+)
German: Upper-intermediate/advanced level ('DSH-Kurs')	C 1/DSH	ca 1,000 hours (B 2+)

### COURSE FORMATS AND FEES

In view of the Corona pandemic, the following course formats are offered:

Type	Format	Form of teaching and learning	Fees
1	Classroom course	Entirely face-to-face teaching, e.g. classes in groups of c. 15 – 17 students with about 22 classroom hours/week at the Language Centre - <b>provided that the course of the Corona pandemic will allow full-time face-to-face teaching.</b>	1,300 €
2	Blended Learning	A mix of remote teaching and face-to-face teaching: Listening, reading, writing, and grammar exercises will be provided on the basis of a course book in virtual classrooms on a Moodle learning platform. In addition, there will be face-to-face teaching in small groups (8 – 10 students) for 10 – 12 classroom hours/week at the Language Centre - <b>provided that the course of the Corona pandemic will allow face-to-face teaching only on a small scale.</b>	1,300 €

### DURATION AND CONTENT OF COURSES

The courses begin on **3 April** and end on **14 July 2023**. The course fee is € 1,300 and includes about 300 hours of language classes, the registration fee and exam fees. The basis for all courses is the university's Moodle learning platform. Here, each course has its own course room where materials and assignments are made available on a digital basis. Our video conferencing system is also integrated into these course rooms.

After receiving the registration fee, we will send you a confirmation letter. This will allow you to apply for a visa if necessary. Registration ends on **15 March 2023**, or when the maximum number of participants has been reached.

## **PAYMENT AND RETURN OF COURSE FEES**

The remaining course fee of € 900 must be paid by bank transfer at the beginning of the course.

**N.B.:** If you need to cancel your registration, the registration fee will be refunded (after a deduction of a € 100 processing fee) only if we have received written notification at least one month before the semester begins. Refunds are no longer possible after this date. If you cancel your registration immediately before or after the beginning of the course, the full course fee has to be paid and cannot be refunded. Exceptions will only be made if visa procedures delay your arrival. If this should be the case, please make sure to let us know as soon as possible.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS FOR REFUGEES**

## **PREVIOUS KNOWLEDGE | PLACEMENT TEST | START OF COURSES**

If the course you have chosen is your first course in Weimar, we need to know something about your previous knowledge. Therefore, please send us copies of any certificates you may have with your registration,

If you have not yet acquired any certificates, it is necessary to take an online placement test in good time before the course begins. Please contact us so that we can send you the necessary information.

If the test shows that your German language skills are not yet sufficient for a DSH course, you will be admitted to one of the other two course levels according to your level. Please note: Admission to the German courses is only possible if you succeed in fulfilling the necessary language requirements.

All courses start on **3 April 2023**.

## **PARTICIPATION IN CLASSES**

Regular participation in the German classes is your key to success, which is why we would like you to let us know in advance if you need to miss a class. Missing classes without an excuse for a prolonged period of time may result in expulsion from the course.

## **DURATION**

The courses last 15 weeks with about 20 hours per week and a total of c. 300 hours. In case of face-to-face teaching, classes are held from 9 – 10.30 and 11.00 – 12.30 a.m., and on some days also from 1.30 – 3.00 p.m. and 3.15 – 4.45 p.m. You will receive a detailed timetable at the beginning of the course. If face-to-face teaching is not possible, you will be informed about the alternatives in advance or at the beginning of the course.

## **NATIONAL HOLIDAYS**

There are no classes on the following days: 7 – 10 April (Easter holiday), 1 May (national holiday) 18/19 May (national holiday), 29 May (national holiday)

## **EXAM TIMES**

All final examinations (including the DSH) will take place between **3 and 14 July 2023**.
