COURSES OFFERED AND LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Together with the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar Language Centre, the Bauhaus Weiterbildungsakademie Weimar e.V. offers the following German intensive courses for prospective students from abroad:

DURATION

The course begins on 1 October 2026 and concludes on 5 February 2027. Course fees include the registration fee, the final exam fee and approximately 280 - 300 hours of language lessons (including the final exam).

All courses are run over the Moodle teaching platform. Each course has its own room where course materials and digital tasks can be found.

Registration closes on **15 September 2026** or once the maximum number of participants has been reached.

PAYMENT AND COURSE FEE REFUNDS

The remaining course fee of € 825 must be transferred by 25 September 2026.

Please note:

Refunds are only possible if the visa was not granted or was granted more than four weeks after the start of the course. Proof of this must be submitted (rejection letter or similar). In these cases, a processing fee of € 100 will be charged. Please inform us as soon as possible via e-mail.

POSSIBLE PARTIAL FEE WAIVER

A partial fee waiver is possible to subsidise academic skills and career preparation. Information on fee waivers is available through the Sprachenzentrum: Centre for Language and Culture's website during the enrolment period.

PREVIOUS KNOWLEDGE | PLACEMENT TEST | START OF COURSES

Please include proof of your German language skills (copies of language certificates etc.) with your application. Admission to the German courses is generally only possible if you meet the language requirements.

All courses begin on 1 October 2026.

A placement test will take place on 1 October 2026. The placement test is required for students who:

- have not yet taken a WBA language course
- have attended a WBA language course, but the final grade was lower than 60%.

COURSE ATTENDANCE

Regular course attendance is important for your academic success. Be sure to notify your instructor in good time if you are unable to attend class. Please note that prolonged unexcused absences may result in being expelled from the course.

TEACHING PERIOD

The German courses run for 15 weeks (including the final exam). Courses are a total of 280 - 300 teaching hours (about 20 hours per week). Courses take place from 8:30 am to 1:15 pm, or in exceptional cases from 1:00 to 5:30 pm. You will receive a detailed schedule at the beginning of your course.

LECTURE-FREE PERIOD

Courses will not be held on the following dates: 14/12/2026 – 1/1/2027 (Winter Holidays).

EXAMINATION PERIOD

All final exams (including the DSH) take place between 1/2/2027 – 5/2/2027.
