Language Centre

Basic

B1 General English (2 ECTS)

This course focuses on practising all four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) with the support of the Language Leader book series. The general courses are broken up into four colour modules, meaning that they can be taken up to four times.

B1/B2 Grammar (2 ECTS)

This course focuses on practising and mastering all of the major tenses in both active and passive, simple and continuous forms. Conditionals and modals will also be included.

** Please note: all basic classes can be taken in conjunction with a tutorial in order to obtain 3 ECTS*

Intermediate

B2 General English (2 ECTS)

This course focuses on practising all four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) with the support of the Language Leader book series. The courses are broken up into four colour modules, meaning that they can be taken up to four times.

B2 Oral Communication Skills (2 ECTS)

This course consists of reading or listening to texts and then breaking into small groups for discussion. Discussions are guided by questions that will be provided. By the end of the semester, students should feel more confident in their English speaking skills.

B2 Writing Skills (2 ECTS)

This writing course will be run on a correspondence basis, with work regularly being submitted and corrected via email and using the university's learning platform Moodle.

C1 Grammar (2 ECTS)

This course is for students who have mastered the basics of English grammar. The course will focus on applying more complex grammar concepts to writing and will enable students to become more proficient with more difficult aspects of English grammar.

B2 English for Technical & Scientific Purposes

This course focuses on communicating in English on technical & scientific topics. The topics discussed in the course are decided according to the students' degree programmes and areas of interest. The winter semester will focus on writing skills and the summer semester on presentation skills.

** Please note: all intermediate classes can be taken in conjunction with a tutorial in order to obtain 3 ECTS*

Upper-Intermediate/Advanced

C1 and C1+ General English (2 ECTS)

This course focuses on practising all four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) with the support of the Language Leader book series. The courses are broken up into four colour modules, meaning that they can be taken up to four times.

C1/C1+ General Writing Skills (2 ECTS)

This writing course will be run on a correspondence basis, with work regularly being submitted and corrected via email and using the university's learning platform Moodle.

C1 Oral Communication Skills (2 ECTS)

This course consists of reading or listening to texts and then breaking into small groups for discussion. Discussions are guided by questions that will be provided. By the end of the semester, students should feel more confident in their English speaking skills.

** Please note: all advanced classes can be taken in conjunction with a tutorial in order to obtain 3 ECTS*

Specialist Courses

C1 English for Technical & Scientific Purposes (NEW: 3 ECTS)

This course focuses on communicating in English on technical & scientific topics. The topics discussed in the course are decided according to the students' degree programmes and areas of interest. The winter semester will focus on writing skills and the summer semester on presentation skills. *Please note: this is a blended learning class: 2 ECTS for classroom work and 1 ECTS for online workload.*

Tutorials

Tutorial (1 ECTS*)

Tutorials are open for all levels and can be combined with all of the main courses. The tutorials are designed to offer students extra practice and obtain an extra credit points. There is no homework or exam.
