

Guidelines for Bauhaus.Semester Projects and Courses

1. The course selection is open to students from **various faculties**. The project requirements can be fulfilled by many students. The methodological and didactic design allows successful participation.

and/or

2. The courses offered use **methods and methodologies** that aim to make them tangible and usable for students studying in different disciplines.

and/or

3. The course offered will be conducted by at least two lecturers from different disciplines, faculties, universities, or with external experts. Subject-specific boundaries will be deliberately transgressed. Guest lecturers will bring **perspectives from other disciplines** and allow the Bauhaus-Universität Weimar to **reflect on the image it projects**.

and/or

4. The courses offered will be designed and **conducted by Bauhaus-Universität Weimar students** and are ideal for students from various disciplines.

and/or

5. The courses offered deal with the **historical idea of Bauhaus** and invite students to engage with **current issues**.

and/or

6. The courses offered will enable students to deal with Bauhaus and contemporary issues in a **local context**--the University, city of Weimar, Region and State of Thuringia. They establish local and regional connections and invite discourse that involves partners from the surrounding area.
