

Student Conference Assistant (m/f/d) Wanted – Support for the TURN Conference 2026

Bauhaus-Universität Weimar will host the TURN Conference of the Stiftung Innovation in der Hochschullehre (StIL) on September 24 and 25, 2026. TURN brings together educators, students, and higher education enthusiasts from the DACH region to shape universities in a transdisciplinary, collaborative, and creative way.

Students will gain insights into conference organisation, have the opportunity to contribute to a major higher education conference, and build hands-on experience in event management.

The University Development office is looking for up to twelve student conference assistants (m/f/d) in two areas of deployment:

1. 8 to 10 people for the immediate preparation and execution of the conference in September 2026, with 25–35 hours/month
2. Up to 3 additional people for execution, follow-up, and documentation from September to November 2026, with 30 hours/month

Responsibilities

The primary focus is supporting the delivery and follow-up of the TURN Conference 2026 on September 24 and 25, 2026 at Bauhaus-Universität Weimar. Tasks include in particular:

- Assisting conference rooms, contributors, and participants
- Supporting the setup, preparation, and dismantling of conference rooms
- Managing the cloakroom and information desk
- Creating photo and video content for Instagram Stories and Reels on @bauhaus_uni
- Supporting the follow-up and documentation of the conference in October/November

- Availability in Weimar on September 24 and 25, 2026, as well as for one or two preparatory meetings
- Independent, structured, careful, and responsible working style
- Strong communication skills in German and English
- Willingness to familiarise yourself with new topics, applications, and workflows
