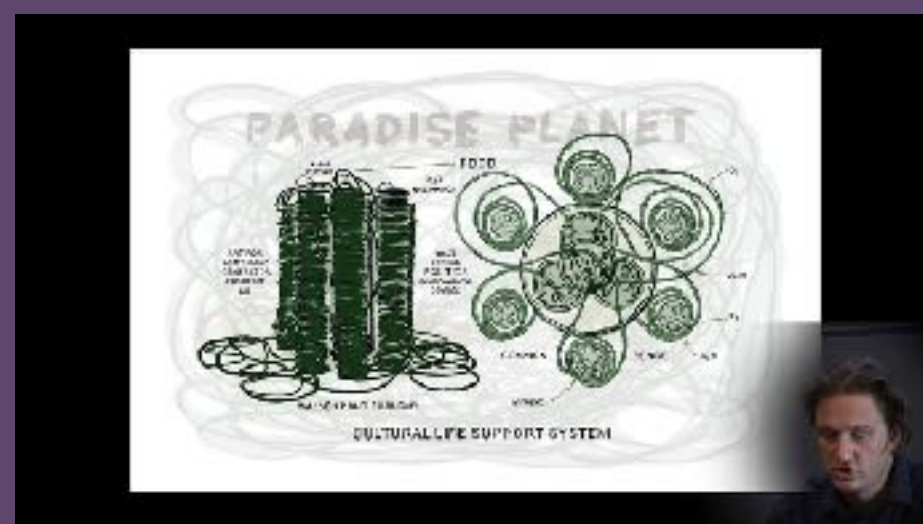

Since 1997 he has taught Art and Media Theory at various universities. In addition to participating in numerous exhibitions, he produces texts, seminars, radio plays, video works, CD-ROMs and websites. The central starting point of his work is everyday life and action in mediatized fields of perception and discourse. In addition to »Soziale Schwerelosigkeit« [Social Weightlessness] (2005), video works like »Interview Antonio Negri« (2003) and »Cut up« (2000) were produced.
