I want to experiment with my process of art making, translating my idea through text and keeping imagery as a helping tool instead of the other way round.

The main idea for the project is to document this time of quarantine through developing a series of quarantine letters/text and self portraits. I want to keep the possibilities of the outcome open and work gradually to the final piece.

I am also trying to involve other individuals. By going around the city and documenting locals in their natural habitat depicting the limitation of social interactions. One approach can be through mail art and design postcards to invite people to participate or involve on the project.
