

# Assignment

The following assignment is due until 30<sup>th</sup> May (Monday) and some of the students have not shown me their old assignments in the class because they were not present or they had forgotten, I would request to do your assignments and show me on coming Monday including the bellow new ones.

## **Section A (Login/Register): %20**

1: Create a MySQL database for the (login, profile) and you should be able to run the example i have attached "PHP SQL", Check the codes to correctly create the database name, table names and fields.

2: Test the Login, Register and Profile page. You should be able to register, and login successfully.

## **Section B (MediaWiki): %40**

1: Download the latest version of MediaWiki

(<https://www.mediawiki.org/wiki/MediaWiki>).

2: Copy MediaWiki to your Web server folder.

3: Access it via browser, and follow the installation steps. (The installation would required a database, you should create a database in your server and provide the name in the installation steps.)

4: After successful installation , LocalSetting.php will be downloaded, copy that file inside the root directory of MediaWiki. (Done)

5: Test MediaWiki by accessing it.

## **Section C (University Media Wiki): %40**

1: Download University MediaWiki from

(<https://github.com/BauhausUniversity/MedienWiki>).

2: The download file contains many folders, copy the Wiki folder to your webserver only.

3: This version requires old version that PHP 5.6 (run your webserver with older php version)

4: Install this MediaWiki, (similar to Section B installation, but this time remove the Localsetting.php file from the root folder)

5: When successfully installed, (Test the server).

4: There is a sample database in archive folder in downloaded files, (Restore that database in your university MediaWiki database).

6: Test the Media Wiki with new data.

There are a lot of how-to for setting up MediaWiki, I would recommend to use the bellow else the instruction I provided would also be sufficient.
