



























Goethe's National Museum

History

This house on the Frauenplan square was built in 1709 in the Baroque style, and Johann Wolfgang on Goethe lived there for nearly fifty years until his death in 1832, initially as a tenant but later as its owner. The poet clearly stamped his Classical artistic ideals on the rooms, You can visit Goethe's and his wife Christiane's living rooms, the poet's study and library, his reception and art collection rooms and the house's garden.
