 Users can plan their own routes or use "discovery mode" which tells them when a historical site is nearby.











At the corner of Bernauer Strasse, Oderberger Strasse and Schwedter Strasse, the Wall took a sharp turn towards the north. After 1989, the former border strip here was converted into a park, called Wall Park (Mauerpark) for this reason. After the Wall came down, a temporary border crossing was set up here on 10 November 1989. A section












Checkpoint Charlie is one of the most historically important locations at the Wall in Berlin. The border crossing at the corner of Friedrichstrasse and Zimmerstrasse was one of three Allied checkpoints, named alphabetically Checkpoint Alpha, Bravo and Charlie. There were several successful escape attempts at Checkpoint Charlie, but even











From the early morning of 13 August 1961, streets in the middle of Berlin are torn up, pieces of asphalt and paving stones are piled on top of each other to form barricades, concrete posts are driven into the ground and barbed-wire barriers are erected.
