
Confusing and Inconsistent icons, a small compilation


I am using Google calendar app for a long time, still sometimes get confused with this "20" of "Today" icon.




Replacing the "20" with "Today" text would cause another problem, that is, different languages.


However, you aren't invisible. Going incognito doesn't hide your browsing from your employer, your Internet service provider or the websites that you visit.


