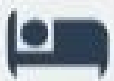

The city of Weimar was a focal point of the German Enlightenment and home of the leading characters of the literary genre of Weimar Classicism, the writers Johann Wolfgang von Goethe and Friedrich Schiller. In the 19th century, famous composers like Franz Liszt made a music centre of Weimar and later, artists and architects like Henry van de Velde, Wassily Kandinsky, Paul Klee, Lyonel Feininger and Walter Gropius came to the city and founded the Bauhaus movement, the most important German design school of the interwar period. However, the political history of 20th-century Weimar was inconsistent: it was the place where Germany's first democratic constitution was signed after the First World War, giving its name to the Weimar Republic period in German politics (1918–1933), as well as one of the cities mythologized by the National Socialist propaganda.

The show house "Am Horn" is an in Weimar built pilot house of the Bauhaus . Initiated the construction of this house was the first Bauhaus exhibition from August 15 to September 30, 1923.

To select the model house of Bauhaus pilot house were the Red Dice by Farkas Molnár and design Georg Muehe , who was realized. The practical implementation of the draft Muehes worried Walter March and Adolf Meyer from Gropius' architectural office, the equipment was a joint effort of all the Bauhaus workshops. Although the house is a prototype, it was a "decent" housing construction, which should be used for years and could. Main idea was to build a settlement for the members of the Bauhaus, to secure the material conditions of life with respect to housing and nutrition to promote the desired working and living community and the workshops to develop a practical action field. As the site of Hornberg was elected on (then) the eastern outskirts of Weimar, a terrain that has been leased

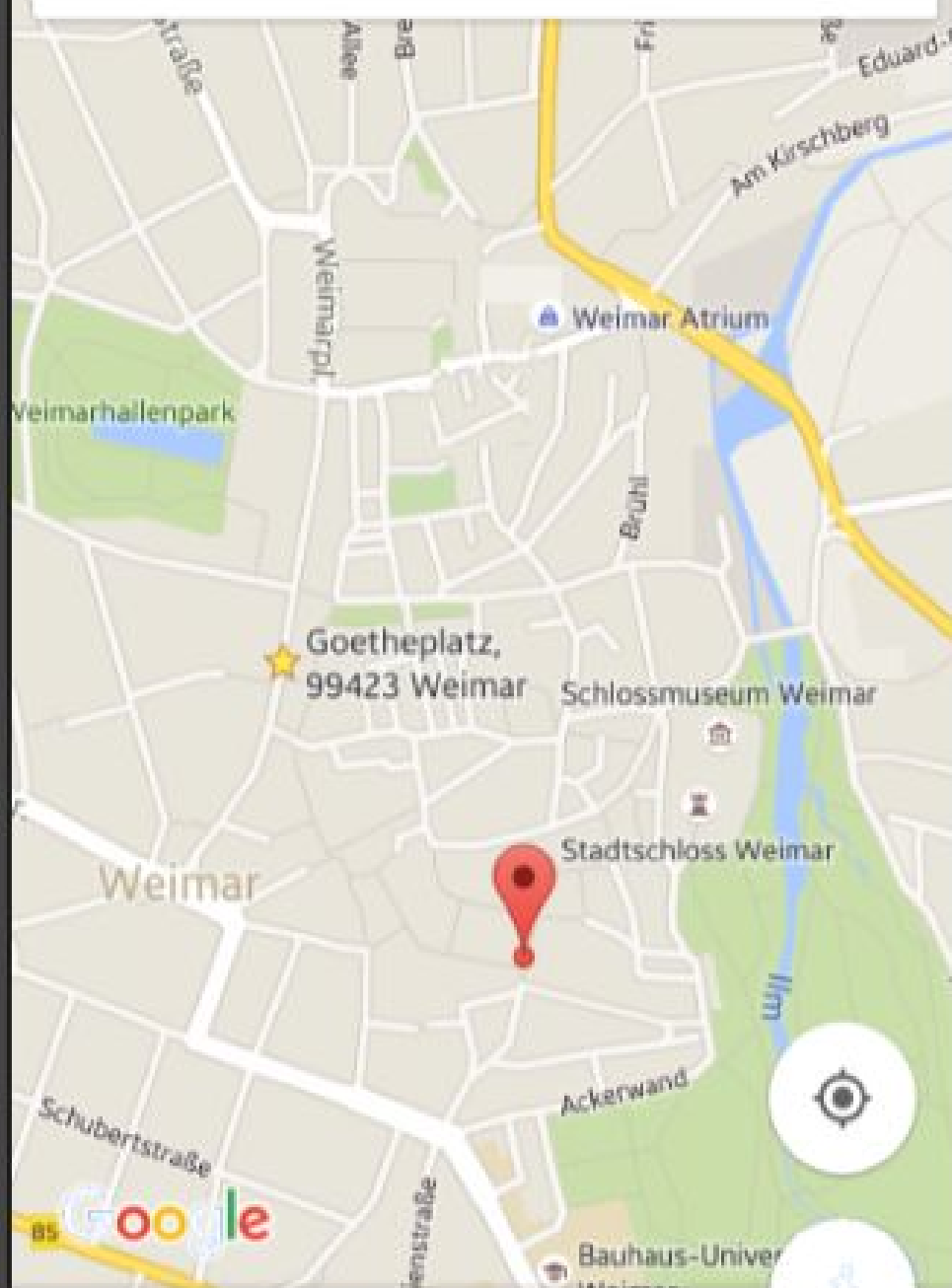
