

Slowly less growth the further away from the branches


Bottom algae due to spray water from rain

Observations include a method of registration / recording.


On the basis of your observation, you may design an experiment to explore the very nature of your observations, question what you observed or to appropriate it.

The last step - which is voluntary - is to get in a conversation with what you have observed, the subject of your observation.
