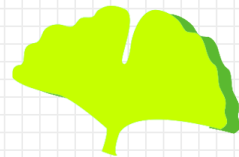

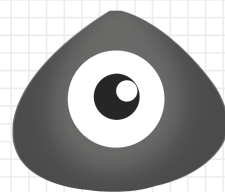

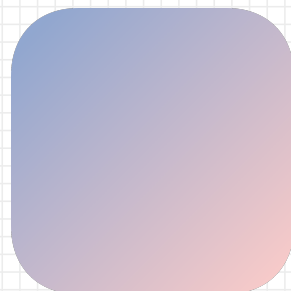
- Weimar — Weimarpedia's Location
