#### Erfurt

Looking to add more beautiful places in Germany to your list? Then you should definitely visit Erfurt with us.

From 1926 to 1932, the city was home to the globally renowned Bauhaus. Bauhaus, founded in Weimar in 1919 by Walter Gropius is one of the most famous schools of architecture & art and stands for architectural icons, minimalist designs and experiments in form and color.

On a guided tour through the Bauhaus School and the Master's House, we will travel back to the time of classical modernism and explore Bauhaus' revolutionary ideas in building, designing and living. Additional input will await you at the Bauhaus Museum. Make use of this one-time opportunity and visit Dessau with us!

#### Fairy Caves in Saalfeld

Let us dive into the lands of fairies and miners at "Feengrotten" (fairy caves) in Saalfeld!

Many centuries ago, the first miners began their search for gold, silver and other valuable metal under the town Saalfeld. In the end, it was alum shale that was discovered there. After the mine was closed in 1850, nature transformed the cave into a colorful and magical underground world known as "Feengrotten".

On a guided tour below the ground, we will not only explore the fairy caves together but also learn about the life and work of the Medieval miners. More input will await us at the interactive museum "Grottoneum", where we can trace the cave's secrets on our own.

#### 09:15 – 19:30 **Sp**

#### Wartburg Castle and Hiking in Eisenach

Do you like history, nature and fairytales? Then join us for a day trip to Eisenach!

Our excursion starts with a visit to Wartburg Castle. The Wartburg, which is almost 1000 years old is one of the most famous castles in Germany and was declared a UNESCO-World Heritage Site in 1999. It owes its extraordinary charisma to its unique architecture and is deeply associated with meaningful personalities and historical events: in 1521/22, Luther himself has translated the bible there!

After our tour through Wartburg, we will continue our trip with a hike in the Thuringian Forest. Eisenach lays in the green heart of Germany and is considered a Mecca for hikers – around 250 kilometers of hiking trails lead to numerous beautiful destinations. We will follow mythical trails and explore the legendary Dragon Gorge together. A place, where sagas come to life and fairytales begin...


#### Guided Tour at "Gedenkstätte Buchenwald"

Come with us and visit the former concentration camp Buchenwald.

The former concentration camp Buchenwald, which was established in the summer of 1937 by the Nazi-regime lays just a few kilometers away from Weimar. From 1937 to 1945, more than one quarter million prisoners were held in the camp. In 1945, the Soviets turned the site into one of their special camps, where they mainly denounced local functionaries and supporters of Nazi-Germany. After 1950, the German Democratic Republic started to build Germany's largest concentration camp memorial. Today, Buchenwald functions as important place of historical enlightenment, international encounter and reconciliation work and commemorates the fate of the victims.

On a guided tour, we will learn more about the former concentration camp. We will not only walk the site, but also get insights into the darkest time of Germany's modern history.

#### Visit of Castle Leuchtenburg in Seitenroda

Discover Leuchtenburg and learn about the world of dreams and wonders of its "white gold"!

A tour guide will lead us through Leuchtenburg's porcelain world and tell us more about the Thuringian craft tradition. Apparently, many wishes have already come true...


#### 13:00 – 17:30 **Sp**

# Further destinations for the weekend that, you can visit on your own:



Historical sights of Goethe and Schiller, picturesque hiking trails, vibrant student life and numerous museums – there is a lot to discover in Thuringia's second biggest city.

Our suggestion: we recommend to visit Jena on Saturday, 01.03. Take the train at 10:34 am from Weimar. You will arrive at 10:48 am at Jena-West. From there on, you can walk within 15 minutes to the city center. After exploring Jena's center, we suggest to take advantage of the city's beautiful nature and hike the mountain "Landgrafen". You do not feel like hiking? Then visit one of Jena's museums such as Schiller's garden house or the phyletic museum instead.

#### Gotha

The city of Gotha not only impresses with architectural highlights from Baroque and Renaissance but also offers many sights to visit.

Our suggestion: we suggest to go to Gotha on Saturday, 01.03. Take the train at 9:54 am. You will reach Gotha at 10:28 am. From the main station, you can walk within 15 minutes to the castle "Friedensstein". The castle, and its fortress, church and museums are definitely worth seeing! Afterwards, we recommend to explore Gotha's old town and have a look at the most famous sights such as "Buttermarkt", the former "Maria Magdalenae" hospital or the historic town hall.

#### Hainich National Park

Hainich National Forest is the largest contiguous deciduous forest area in Germany and invites visitors to linger, stroll and relax.

Our suggestion: we recommend to go to Hainich National Park on Sunday, 02.03 and hike the tree top trail. Take the train at 10:13 am from Weimar to Bad Langensalza. Once arrived in Bad Langensalza, please change to the Hainichbus (bus line 151) and get off at the station "Thiemsburg, Schönstedt" at 11:56 am. Simply follow the signs to the Hainich National Center. You can buy tickets for the tree top trail there.

Please inform yourself about possible changes/delays of trains as well as opening times and entry prices of sightseeing attractions!


#### Movie Night




