It lays just a few kilometers away from Weimar. **From 1937 to 1945, more than one quarter million prisoners were held in the camp.** Today, Buchenwald functions as important place of **historical enlightenment, international encounter and reconciliation work and commemorates the fate of the victims.** On a guided tour, we will walk the site and learn more about the former concentration camp.
