A resistance to the ratio, as a promise of interaction.




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Project is an interactive public art intervention into the main hall of the train station in Gotha. Installation is attached to the roof of the interior and consists of an animated geometric shapes of triangles capable to rotation in respect to each other. Animation is controlled by the sensors which captures the passenger passing by under the constriction. By triggering the motion, the reflective triangle plates of the installation begin to rotate, and thus affect the light emission inside the space underneath.



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
